Identification photo (color, 3.5cm * 4.5cm) (headshot, front view on white background)</li> <li>2. A color copy of the passport</li> <li>3. Academic transcript (English)</li> <li>4. Letter of recommendation (English)</li> <li>5. A self-medical checkup form</li> <li>6. Agreement on personal information</li> <li>7. Certificate of enrollment (Apostilled)</li> <li>8. Bank balance certificate – At least 4,500,000 KRW deposited (Apostilled)</li> </ol> <p>* If applicable, other certificates such as language, activities, etc.</p> <p><b>Note</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Number 7 and 8 documents are exclusively for students based on nationality from non-OECD member countries.</b> Please provide the original copy via international post.</li> <li>- After the period of official nomination, information about the online application process will be given via email to partners and nominated students.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Visa Process</b></p>	<p><b>Please contact the embassy in your country for details, as the process may vary among countries.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Keimyung will issue and send the certificate of admission.</li> <li>- Generally, each student needs to submit the documents listed below to the Korean Embassy in their country.             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Valid Passport (validity of at least 6 months)</li> <li>b. Certificate of admission</li> <li>c. Business registration of the host university</li> <li>d. Completed visa application form</li> <li>e. Recent certificate of school record</li> <li>f. Verification of bank account balance</li> <li>g. Visa processing fee</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

<b>Courses / English Language Proficiency</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Exchange students typically enroll in the courses offered in English. Therefore, an intermediate/high level of English proficiency is required to take these courses.</li> <li>- Certificates (e.g., TOEFL / IELTS) are not required.</li> <li>- Students may choose to register for the courses offered in Korean. However, an intermediate/high level of Korean proficiency is required to take these courses.</li> </ul>
<b>Alien Registration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All international students must apply for the alien registration card (ARC), which is mandatory in Korea, upon arrival.</li> <li>- Students <b>cannot</b> apply for the registration on their own, as the immigration office does not accept individual applications. The application can only be submitted through the university.</li> </ul>
<b>Health Insurance</b>	<p><b>Compulsory</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All international students are required to have national insurance from the Republic of Korea (approximately \$70 per month). They will be automatically enrolled when they apply for their alien registration card.</li> </ul> <p><b>Optional</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students may individually purchase traveler's insurance.</li> </ul>
<b>Housing</b>	<p><b>Dormitory application</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students can apply for a dormitory when submitting the online application form.</li> <li>- <b>All students are guaranteed campus housing if they apply during the online application period.</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Dormitory Fee (As of Spring Semester 2024)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- General Hall (2 persons/room) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. With two meals a day: KRW 1,501,000</li> <li>b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,116,000</li> <li>c. Without meal: KRW 636,000</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Bongsu (male only) / Hyupruk Hall (female only) (2 persons/room) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. With two meals a day: KRW 2,103,000</li> <li>b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,718,000</li> <li>c. Without meal: KRW 1,238,000</li> </ul> </li> <li>- <u>Please note that the above information is for reference only, and dormitory fees may vary each semester.</u></li> </ul> <p><b>Note</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students are strongly encouraged to transfer money from a bank in their country or with the WISE service during the payment period.
