

Introduction to Oriel College, Oxford

Oriel College is a constituent college of the University of Oxford, some 700 years old which houses a community of academics and students teaching and studying at the University. We are small – around 600 students in total- which makes for a friendly close-knit community. In the summer we are able to open our doors to invite talented students from across the world to study with our academics on our Summer Institute programmes held in July and August each year.

Introduction to the programme

The Summer Institute at Oriel presents an opportunity for you to study directly with Oxford academics on a select number of programmes. These have been chosen from the wide range of subjects taught here at Oriel, and the courses crafted specifically for our short course summer study students. Learning in a maximum group of 30 students, your tutor will work with you over two week delivering a curated curriculum. Your lectures will take place either morning or afternoon each day and then you will continue with your studies or take the time to enjoy the beautiful city of Oxford and all it has to offer.

Academic tutors

The tutors who teach at the Summer Institute are drawn either directly from Oriel or from close colleagues across the University of Oxford. The programme is managed by the most senior academics at Oriel including the Senior Tutor, Senior Dean and a subject Fellow for each stream. This ensures the quality of the programme you would expect both in terms of content and teaching is maintained at the highest level.
